SPECIAL INJUNCTION ORDER

AND NOW, this 9th day of November, 2006, upon consideration of the Complaint in Equity, Petition for Special and Preliminary Injunction, and the accompanying papers in support thereof filed by plaintiffs SmithKline Beecham Corporation d/b/a GlaxoSmithKline ("GSK"), Esther Cheung, Minne Iwamoto and Rosemary LeCompte (the "Individual Plaintiffs"), and, after consideration of any responses made thereto by defendants Stop Huntingdon Animal Cruelty USA, Inc., Hugs for Puppies, Inc., Nicholas Cooney, David Lambon, Christopher Semick, and Amandah Povilitus, it is hereby determined that:

1. Plaintiffs have demonstrated a clear right to relief and a reasonable likelihood of success on the merits of the claims in their Complaint;
2. Plaintiffs will suffer immediate and irreparable harm and loss if an injunction is not issued and such harm outweighs any harm to defendants from the granting of an injunction;
3. The injunction will restore the parties to the status quo as it existed before defendants' unlawful conduct and is reasonably suited to abate such unlawful conduct;
4. The injunction is in the public interest;

5. Plaintiffs have no adequate remedy at law;

WHEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED and DECREED that:

6. The above named defendants, individually and collectively, and all persons acting in any manner at their behest or in concert with them, directly or indirectly, are hereby ENJOINED from:

(a) committing any act of violence or making any threat of violence against GSK, the Individual Plaintiffs and/or any person otherwise affiliated with or providing goods or services to GSK and the Individual Plaintiffs, including any person known or believed to be a GSK employee;

(b) vandalizing, damaging, or threatening to vandalize or damage real or personal property belonging to GSK, the Individual Plaintiffs and/or any person otherwise affiliated with or providing goods or services to GSK and the Individual Plaintiffs, including any person known or believed to be a GSK employee;

(c) harassing, stalking, menacing, intimidating GSK, the Individual Plaintiffs and/or any person otherwise affiliated with or providing goods or services to GSK and the Individual Plaintiffs, including any person known or believed to be a GSK employee;

(d) trespassing, entering, coming onto, or interfering with the use and enjoyment of any real property owned, occupied, or in the possession of GSK, the Individual Plaintiffs and/or any person otherwise affiliated with or providing goods or services to GSK and the Individual Plaintiffs, including any person known or believed to be a GSK employee;

(e) violating any Ordinances in effect within the relevant jurisdiction or any other similar local regulation regarding noise, disturbing the peace, property damage,

impeding or obstructing the free passage of pedestrians, and/or the distribution of flyers or handbills;

(f) placing or maintaining upon any website or otherwise disseminating any private or personal information, including but not limited to, names, home addresses, home phone numbers, mobile phone numbers, e-mail addresses, bank account numbers, credit card numbers, social security numbers, vehicle license plate numbers, or drivers' license numbers, regarding GSK, the Individual Plaintiffs and/or any person otherwise affiliated with or providing goods or services to GSK and the Individual Plaintiffs, including any person known or believed to be a GSK employee;

(g) making any phone calls, sending any email messages, or otherwise sending communications of a threatening or harassing nature, or directing, causing or inducing or encouraging others to make any phone calls, send any email messages, or otherwise send communications of a threatening or harassing nature to GSK's offices, the Individual Plaintiffs and/or any person otherwise affiliated with or providing goods or services to GSK and the Individual Plaintiffs, including any person known or believed to be a GSK employee;

(h) in any manner whatsoever engaging in any picketing, demonstrating, leafleting, protesting or congregating within one hundred (100) feet of the walk-in and drive-through gates reserved for employees of GSK, the public wishing to do business with GSK and other personnel at GSK's facilities in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, or otherwise preventing or obstructing any ingress or egress of people, vehicles, or any deliveries to or from GSK's facilities located in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania;

(i) in any manner whatsoever engaging in any picketing, demonstrating, leafleting, protesting or congregating:

- locations;
- (i) within one hundred (100) feet of the aforementioned
 - (ii) in a group of more than 10 persons;
 - (iii) more than once every other week;
 - (iv) for more than one hour;
 - (v) outside of 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday;
 - (vi) with any amplification device, including but not limited to bullhorns;
 - (vii) wearing masks, bandanas, hoods, or other items intended to cover faces and conceal identities; and
 - (viii) without notifying the relevant law enforcement organization at least 72 hours in advance of any such protest of the time of the protest, the number of protestors, and the anticipated duration of the protest;
- (j) in any manner whatsoever engaging in any picketing, demonstrating, leafleting, protesting or congregating within one hundred (100) feet of the homes of the Individual Plaintiffs and/or any person otherwise affiliated with or providing goods or services to GSK and the Individual Plaintiffs, including any person known or believed to be a GSK employee;
- (k) in any manner whatsoever engaging in any picketing, demonstrating, leafleting, protesting or congregating at the homes of any of the Individual Plaintiffs and/or any person otherwise affiliated with or providing goods or services to GSK and the Individual Plaintiffs, including any person known or believed to be a GSK employee:

- (i) within one hundred (100) feet of the aforementioned homes;
- (ii) in a group of more than 5 persons;
- (iii) more often than once every other week;
- (iv) for more than one hour;
- (v) outside of ¹⁰ a.m. to ¹² p.m., Monday through Friday;
- (vi) with any amplification device, including but not limited to bullhorns;
- (vii) wearing masks, bandanas, hoods, or other items intended to cover faces and conceal identities; and

(viii) without notifying the appropriate law enforcement organization at least 72 hours in advance of any such protest of the time of the protest, the number of protestors, and the anticipated duration of the protest;

(l) in any manner whatsoever engaging in any action or conduct which is intended to or has the necessary effect of threatening, intimidating, harassing or coercing the Individual Plaintiffs and/or any person otherwise affiliated with or providing goods or services to GSK and the Individual Plaintiffs, including any person known or believed to be a GSK employee;

(m) in any manner whatsoever interfering with, hindering or obstructing the ingress and egress to GSK's facilities in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania;

7. That defendants, each of them, and their members, supporters, officers, agents, employees, representatives, affiliates, and all persons acting in concert with them, shall post on all websites owned, operated or controlled by any of the defendants, which relate to

animal rights or a campaign against HLS, the following language: "Notice: The Court of Common Pleas of Philadelphia County, Pennsylvania has issued an order prohibiting certain activity relating to GlaxoSmithKline, and persons or entities having business or economic relations with GlaxoSmithKline"; and post the foregoing statement as a continuously visible underlined hyperlink which, when clicked, displays only a legible, complete and unmodified, copy of all pages of this Order;

8. That no person who has notice of the relief described above shall fail to comply with its letter and spirit nor shall any person subvert the letter or spirit by any sham, indirection or other artifice;

9. The Sheriff's Office of Philadelphia County and/or the Individual Plaintiffs and GSK through their attorneys, or any competent adult authorized by the Individual Plaintiffs and GSK, are authorized to serve true but uncertified copies of the complaint and injunction upon any of the defendants and upon any persons acting in concert with them or otherwise participating with them or acting in their aid or on their behalf.

10. A hearing on whether the aforesaid Special Injunction should be continued is scheduled at 9:30 a.m. on November 14th, 2006 in Courtroom 232, Broad and Market Streets, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.


11. The Court shall retain jurisdiction over the complaint to determine that the decree of this Court is obeyed and the Sheriff's Office of Philadelphia County or any other law enforcement agency having jurisdiction over the enjoined parties are hereby authorized and directed to enforce this Special Injunction Order by whatever lawful means deemed appropriate, and to arrest and bring before this Court on charges of contempt any and all persons interfering with the enforcement of the Order.

This Order shall become effective immediately upon plaintiffs filing an approved surety bond, or depositing cash with the Prothonotary, in the amount of \$ _____, conditioned for the payment of such costs and damages as may be incurred or suffered by any party who is found to have been wrongfully enjoined or restrained.

13. ANY VIOLATION OF THIS ORDER SHALL RESULT IN IMPOSITION OF A FINE OF NOT LESS THAN \$500.00 FOR EACH SUCH VIOLATION.
